DEPARTURE NEWS

As our deputation "phase" of ministry begins to come to an end, we now want to keep you updated on how our departure to the field develops. We have an appointment this week with the post office to get Gavin's passport finalized, and we are in the process of Alicia's passport renewal. Once we have received these two items, we can then begin the process of getting or visas approved in the Nashville Japanese Embassy. *Please pray that we receive these passports in a quick and timely fashion.*

PREPARATIONS AND PRAISES

As we continue to prepare for our departure in the Spring we would like to keep you updated on our goals, and the progress:

- 1. We have currently have had 85% of the needed funds listed below committed to help facilitate our relocation to Japan! PRAISE THE LORD! :
 - a. Approx. \$10,000 for the cost of our shipping container wherein will be some of our household goods and needed supplies for Faith Baptist Church.
 - b. Approx. \$5,000 for the cost of tickets and bus fare to get us from Chattanooga to Iwakuni, Japan.
 - c. Approx. \$5,000 to cover any costs of visas, passports, down payments for rented home once arriving, etc.

We are still in need of funds to help cover the third expense goal, but being that God has already, through such amazing supporting churches and families, provided the other two goals, we are confident that this final financial need will be met soon.

2. To start seeing the final 4% of our needed support coming in by the end of March. Although we have received several verbal commitments in the last several weeks, we are trying to be wise in discerning the balance of scheduling more meetings and making final preparations for departure. We have a couple of meetings that have been scheduled between now and April, which we hope will continue to help us meet the goals set forth in the last couple of prayer letters. That being said, however, we are firmly set to leave in the Spring, Lord willing.
