DEPUTATION NEWS

During the month of June, Alicia and I arrived back from our eventful and eye opening survey trip to Iwakuni. We were scheduled to be gone for an entire month (from May to June), so we did not schedule any immediate meetings in the weeks following our arrival. However, God had been at work in ways we never expected. As we started about our first real day home, attempting to reacclimate to some state of normalcy (a constantly changing state while you are on deputation), I received a phone call from a dear friend of ours, Bro. Ernie Fritz. During one of his recent meetings, the Pastor of Eagle Furnace Baptist Church asked if he knew of any military missionaries who they could support as a church. Bro. Ernie passed on a packet containing information about some missionaries that are currently on deputation. After praying over the information and showing it to the church family, the church decided to take us on as their missionaries! What an encouragement to hear this from a man who travels regularly (taking no support for himself) just to try to get churches to jump behind military missionaries. Please pray the Bro. Ernie Fritz as he helps maintain the offices at BIMI and travels about the country seeking to make churches aware of this great ministry.

PRAYERS AND PLANNING

After spending time in Iwakuni, and allowing God to settle in our hearts that this is where He has for us to go, Alicia and I have begun speaking with Pastor and Mrs. Parker and plan for the future of Faith Baptist Church. I will detail some of the work that is going on at Marine Corps Air Station in a coming email (At least as much as I am allowed to impart that is), but suffice it to say that there is much work to be done! When we leave for the field in June of next year (Lord willing), Alicia and I will need to ship our household goods over in a container. Some of the items will be things we needed to buy as they are either very hard to find or very expensive in Iwakuni. However, we will also plan to ship over some new/used pew chairs as well. Please pray we can either buy some new ones at a good price, or find a church that is remodeling and would be willing to sell them. We also would like to ask you to begin praying about how we can make space for the church family as it grows. If you have any specific questions, please feel free to email me for information.
